



## Standard Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs)

Metropolitan areas consist of one or more counties, except in the New England states, where the areas are cities and towns.

In order to be defined as a metropolitan area by these standards, the area's population must satisfy the following:

- a city with a population of 50,000 or more, or
- an urbanized area with a population of at least 50,000, provided that the component counties had a population of at least 100,000.
